Measurement of Overall Improvment

Youth Outcome Questionnaire (Y-OQ) 2023

The Youth Outcome Questionnaire (Y-OQ) is a tool developed to measure adolescent functioning. The Y-OQ has been validated and normed and is considered useful in measuring the progress of teens who may require outpatient or inpatient treatment. Lower scores mean fewer problems and better functioning. The Y-OQ helps us track improvement directly from their perspective – a vital measure of how they experience their healing journey during and after treatment.

Students complete the Y-OQ at enrollment, discharge, six months, and one year post-discharge. This self-reported data helps us measure progress and long-term impact.



When reviewing Y-OQ scores, it's important to understand that lower scores indicate better emotional and behavioral health. The goal is to see the scores of our students decrease over time. A downward trend reflects meaningful progress as students build coping skills, improve emotional regulation, and move toward overall well-being.
